

*Lochboisdale lies on the Southern end of the Western isles and as such is dominated by the Gulf Stream and associated weather patterns. Generally the prevailing wind direction is SW for which the Lochboisdale and Gasay Harbour provides an excellent sheltered berth. Being in the gulf stream the temperatures are never too extreme which is beneficial especially for winter storage as there is very little problem here with sub zero temperatures and the associated freezing damage that can be experienced in other northern marinas and ports.*

*The land is generally low lying to the west and south of the port and to the north is a large mountain range that runs up the East coast of the Uists which takes the brunt of the Northerly gales in the winter sheltering the Harbour from the worst of a Northerly wind.*
